

## **DOMES VALLEY RACEWAY NEWSLETTER**

Dome Valley Raceway is proud to host the 3rd Annual October Showdown on October 20-21, 2012. The Swag Racing team will again be helping run the event. This event will serve as the 7th of 8 NSRA point series events for the 2012 season. We are looking forward to this event setting up a thrilling Season Finale with championships on the line.

The October Showdown will be our normal two day event format for Dome Valley Raceway. Saturday will feature our Open Pro, Sportsman, & Junior bracket classes as well as all Heads-Up qualifying. Sunday will be the day for Heads-Up & Pro Bracket class eliminations.

We will continue our popular Free Entry drawing for pre-registered racers for this event. The pre-registration must be postmarked by October 12, 2012 to be eligible for a refund for one paid pre-entered class. Also, Torco Race Fuels will be available at this event via pre-order. Pre-ordering can be accomplished by calling Torco at 480-288-9385.

The scoreboards are finally functional for this event at Dome Valley Raceway. We wouldn't want to leave anyone out, so here is a big thank you to everyone who has helped us get down the long road to getting the scoreboards working. Now that we have fully functioning scoreboards, be sure to check your dial-ins on the scoreboard before each pass. If your dial-in is not correct, make sure to stop & let us know to change it. As always, the rule at Dome Valley is that you can change your dial any round. Make sure to go to the staging lane director before that round to give him the dial change.

There will be two licensing opportunities for new drivers in the Heads-Up classes offered at 8AM & 10AM on Saturday morning. If a new driver misses these sessions, they will have to license during the qualifying sessions.

We are going to try something new to expedite the show & keep our bracket racing action flowing throughout the day. During the Top Fuel & Top Alcohol qualifying and eliminations rounds, we will run one pair of those cars, then run 3-4 pairs of the next Bracket Car class that is set in the lanes. The staging lane director will give plenty of notice to that particular class, and to which pairs will be pulled during that particular cycle.

In the past, we have had issues with the P.A. system & FM transmitter. We continue to diligently try to fix those issues. For this race, we are confident at least that the FM transmitter will function much better. The station that the race will be broadcast on is 95.7FM.
